2. Kirandeep Kour D/o Sh. Charanjit Singh R/o Sainik Colony Jammu
3. Er. Nimrandeep Singh S/o S. Bhupinder Singh R/o Sainik Colony Jammu

Whereas it is thought for and unanimously decided by the settlers that a trust be created which will be known as KARAM INTERNATIONAL TRUST FOR EDUCATION. Now this indenture deed hereby witness as follows:-

- 1 That settlers mentioned above hereby form and create this trust with its registered head office at Sector-C Sainik Colony Jammu or any other place mutually decided by the trustees for carrying out the purpose mentioned herein.
- 2 Trustees convenient with the settlers and their respective heirs executors and administrators that they, the trustees will stand possess of the cash and bank balance (hereinafter in their presents designated as the trust fund) upon the trust for the income and subject to the posers, provisions, direction and agreements hereinafter declared and contained of concerning trust.
- 3 Only the income by and out of and not the corps of the trust fund shall be spent as the subjects of the trust.
- 4 The trustees may at any time make such arrangements draw up such schemes and make and frame such files as they in their controlled discretion think fit for the administration of the trust hereby constituted and the management schemes of rules they shall think fit.
- 5 It is hereby clearly understood and provided that in spite of the fact that this land and any other assets of the trust may stand purchased/registered in the name of any individance persons and their successors and assigners have no claim or right over the properties purchased for trust any deed documents etc. in respect of the demised property executed in the name of trust shall be owned and be acted upon by the trustees as if they were executed by the trust itself (The trust shall and hereby deemed to be the lawful successor to the property under any one or more of trustees jointly the said property can only be disposed off with the consent of all the trustees and shall be in the interest of the trust)

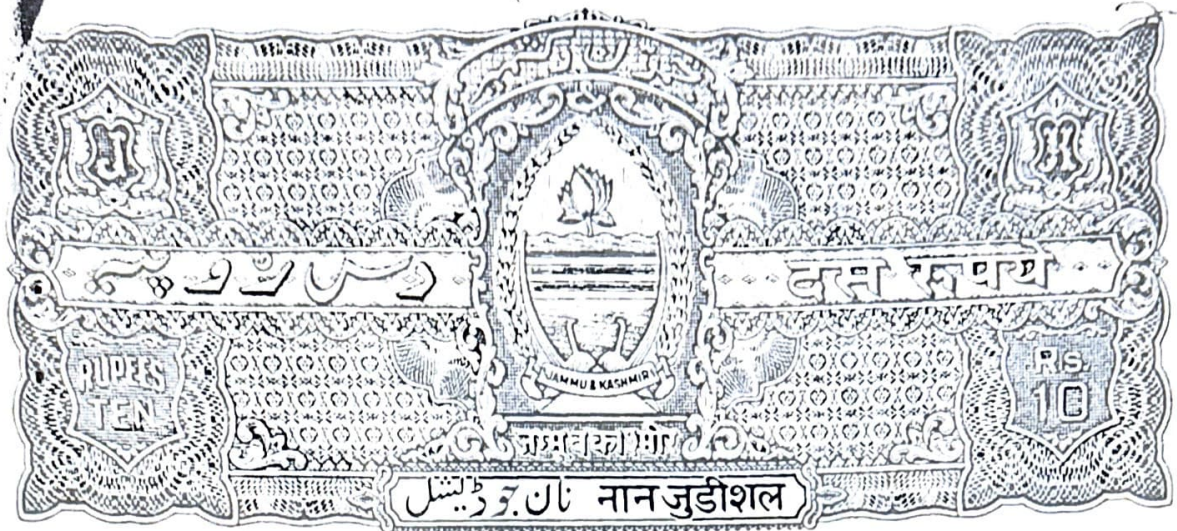

6 THE OBJECTS FOR WHICH THIS TRUST IS CREATED ARE:-

- a To establish , maintain or run in any part of India or aboard Colleges, School or institutes with or without branches for imparting general, scientific , vocational, commercial, engineering, technical or any other type of education to the students orally or through post or other modes on such terms and conditions laid down by the trust time to time and for this purpose , to establish libraries , read rooms , laborites , workshops and install equipments and to arrange for their maintenance and upkeep.
- b To act as franchise holders or to give franchise to others for imparting technical , scientific or other education on modern lines . To publish books, periodicals, and other literary works and to organized exhibitions to spread educations among common masses as may be thought fit from time to time either alone or in conjunction with others.
- c To set up centers to carry in research in the field of education with a view to evolve new and scientific methods of education at various levels and to act as educational experts and consultants.
- d To give grants to organizations and institutions connected with any of the object of the trust.
- e To accept in cash or kind donations, subscriptions, grants and presents to collect dividends interests rents lease and other incomes of and for the trust fund only.
- f This trust is a private trust, the income and property of this trust shall be employed towards the promotion and development of the objects of the trust i.e for the development of the education.
- g To acquire immovable property for the purpose of the trust and to dispose off trust property not required for its purpose.
- h To pay all costs charges and expensive incidental to the formation management, administration and execution of the trust and power herein contained.
- i To dispose off transfer and otherwise deal with the subject matter of the trust in such manner as the trustees may deem fit and proper to do it carrying out the objectives of the trust .
- j To raise or borrow money required for the purpose of the trust with or without security including mortgage or pledge or change of the trust property.
- k To take over the management of any other trust if any public or private institutions engaged in the activities permissible under the objects of the trust and to do all such act deed and things that are identical and necessary for and conductive to the object of the trust.

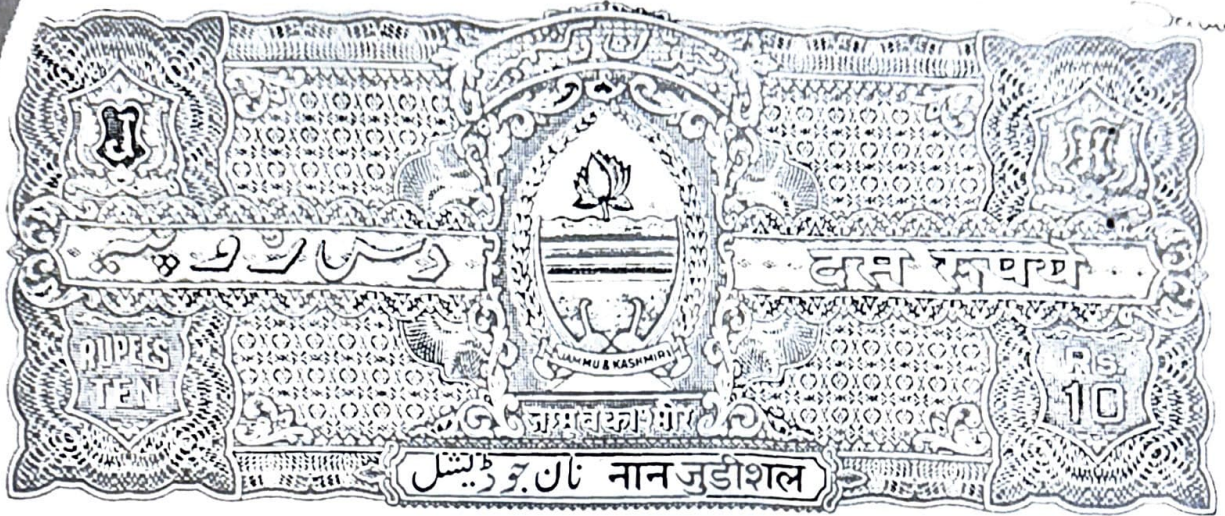

7 The management and control of the trust and its properties shall vest in the board of trustees who are empowered to carry on the administration of the trust for and on its behalf and its name including power to increase or expenditure both for acquisition of any immovable and for movable assets as also for carrying day to day work

8 The board of trustees shall have power to borrow money for the purpose of trust from any bankers, financial institutions or other whether on security of assets and properties of the trust or without any security and such terms as may be deemed fit by them.

9 The number of trustees shall not be less than three but not more than eleven. The First trustees are those who have signed this trust deed having agreed to act as trustees.

10 The trustees for the time being shall have the powers to co-opt other persons as trustees but at no time to the total number of trustees shall exceed eleven.

11 If a trustee die or desire it be relieved or refuse to act as such or become incapable of acting as such or is convicted of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude or is absent from the meeting without permission in writing from the trust such trustees shall be deemed to have vacated his office as trustees.

12 The quorum of a meeting of the trustees shall be three but in case of the membership of the board exceeds nine the quorum shall be five

13 The decision of the board of the trustees shall be taken by a majority board, in case of equality of votes the chairman shall have the an additional casting vote.

14 The trustees may a reach a decision by resolution shall be valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of trustees held in accordance with the provisions of those presence

15 The settlers shall frame rules and regulations for the administration of the trust fund, income revolution and conduct of meeting enlistment of members extra from time to time. The rules framed by the settlers can be amended by them by majority of 2/3 rd of the total number of the settlers for the time being

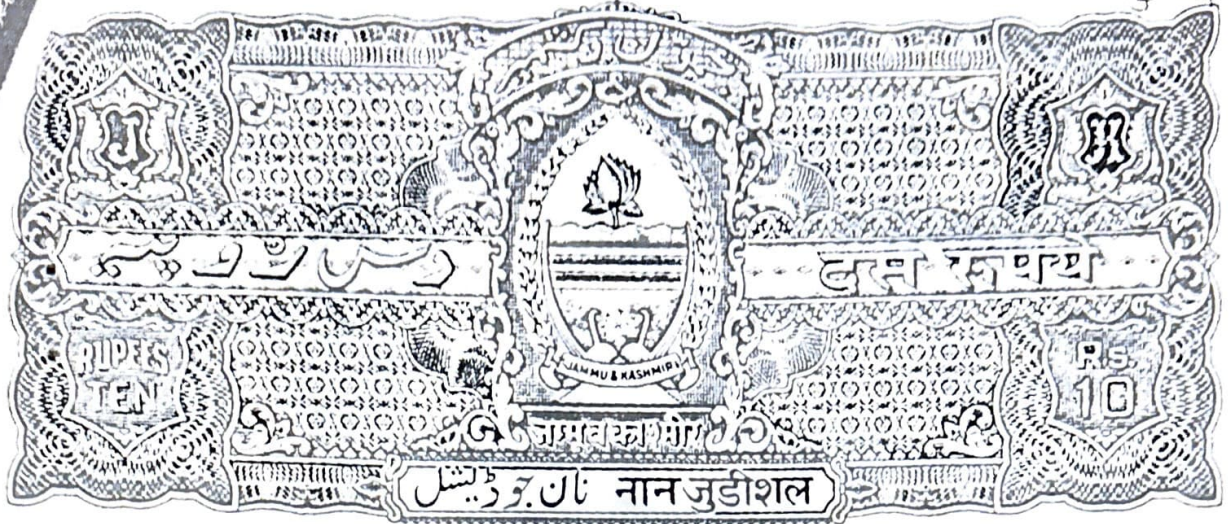
